

## STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR MICRO SPRINTS LINE-UP

- 1. All drivers will purchase ticket at front window to be able to draw.
- 2. All drivers will draw a number at pit shack to determine starting position for qualifying heat.
- 3. Number of heat races to be determined by number of cars entered.
  - 1 Heat Up to 9 Cars
  - 2 Heats 10 to 20 Cars
  - 3 Heats 21 to 30 Cars
  - 4 Heats 31 to 38 Cars
  - 5 Heats 39 to 46 Cars
  - 6 Heats 47 Cars and up
- 4. Feature line up to be determined as follows:
  - Cars will be lined up heads up according to heat race finish.

    Heat winners, followed by 2nd place finishers, 3rd place finishers, etc.
- 5. Winner of final heat race will pull number at pit shack to determine the number of cars to be inverted for feature line up. (0, 3, 6, 9, 12)
- 6. Number pulled for inversion will be removed from picks for next event.
- 7. After number is pulled at next event, then previous event invert number will be returned to the draw. (Therefore no number can be drawn two events in a row, and after first event the number of picks available in the draw will be four each week.)
- 8. Number of cars qualifying from heat races to be determined by number of heats.
- 9. Cars qualifying from consolation to start behind cars qualifying from heats.
- 10. Any drivers with provisionals to start at back of feature field.
