Reimert Racing Oley, PA

Louden Reimert is a 13 year old Honor Roll student of the Oley Valley Middle School whose main interest is in racing. Loudens racing career started in 2006 at the age of 5 in the Jr. Novice division at the Montgomery County Quarter Midget Club in Phoenixville (PA). Over the years Louden competed in various Quarter Midget classes and has accumulated many wins. In 2010 Louden made the move from Quarter Midgets to Junior Slingshots. With experience and determination, at the age of 11, Louden started competing in the All Star Slingshot division while still competing in some Junior events in 2012. (The drivers in the "All Star" division are typically two – three times the age of Louden.)

2013 was Loudens first full race season of competing in the All-Star Slingshot division. Loudens season was full of successes and honors including a fast time record award, five feature wins and many top ten finishes. The biggest highlight was a clean sweep at Path Valley Speedway, Fall Jamboree (Spring Run, PA) . Louden clinched both feature wins that weekend and earned a 2nd place finish in the All Star National Point battle. Louden was awarded the Rookie of the Year honor at both Linda's Speedway (Jonestown, PA) and Action Track USA (Kutztown, PA)



In 2014 Loudens goal was to concentrate on winning as many races as he could and make a serious run for the All Star National Point Championship. With over 60 races on the season calendar, competing at 12 various racing facilities throughout PA and NY, Louden was looking forward to the challenges and experiences. Louden gained valuable seat time and experience on the big car tracks as well as the little car tracks: Penn Can Speedway (Susquehanna, PA), 5 Mile Point Speedway (Kirkwood, NY), Accord Speedway (Accord, NY),

Grandview Speedway (Bechtelsville, PA), Airport Speedway (New Castle, DE), Susquehanna Speedway Park (York Haven, PA) and Shellhammers Speedway (Leesport, PA). Two asphalt tracks were also on the schedule in 2014: Borgers Speedway (Saylorsburg, PA) and Mahoning Valley Speedway (Lehighton, PA). Louden raced 3 weekly tracks most of the summer: Linda's Speedway (Jonestown, PA; finished the season 8th in points with one feature win), Hamlin Speedway (Hamlin, PA; finished 5th in points), Action Track USA (Kutztown, PA; finished 7th in points with one feature win). When the 2014 National All Star points were compiled, Louden earned the Mid-Atlantic Silver All Star Point Championship. Completing the 2014 race season, Louden also earned 8th in the Mid-Atlantic Gold Points and 7th place in the National All Star Points.

Racing many of the same tracks as in 2014, Louden is hoping to add Bridgeport Speedway's ¼ mile to his resume in 2015.
